Maynooth College: This year Maynooth College celebrates its 225th anniversary and a beautifully presented volume captures a multi-dimensional perspective of an institution that has held a singular place in modern Irish Church history. "We Remember Maynooth: A College Across Four Centuries" edited by Salvador Ryan and John-Paul Sheridan is a collection of essays that paints a rounded picture of a unique college, through whose hallowed halls have passed both kings and popes. Price €50. From modest beginnings in 1795 as a small seminary of thirty students and ten professors, Maynooth expanded rapidly, becoming a Pontifical University, a constituent college of the National University of Ireland and, at one time, the largest seminary in world. It has educated many thousands of students and led the way in many branches of the arts and sciences.
