**Part-time Higher Diploma in Theological Studies via Blended Learning:** Interested in studying Theology ? The one year, part-time Higher Diploma in Theological Studies at St Patrick's College, Maynooth is now offered as a "Blended Learning" programme. Suitable for those with an undergraduate degree in any discipline (or equivalent). The course will run from September 2020 to May 2021, with online lectures taking place on Wednesday evenings. There will also be six residential weekends over the course of the year. This programme can serve as a pathway into programmes which require a background in Theology, such as the Higher Diploma in Healthcare Chaplaincy or Masters in Theology. The course also meets the Teaching Council's requirements for the teaching of Religion in Secondary Schools. Closing date for applications is 14<sup>th</sup> August. **Holy Communion:** Receive Holy Communion in your hand only. Holy Communion will be distributed at the Altar, and at the very end of Mass.

**The Act of Spiritual Communion:** is prayed at each Mass for all following the live broadcast of Mass on our Parish Facebook Page and for anyone who feels uncomfortable to come to the altar to receive Holy Communion.

**Our Churches Capacity:** Tynagh Church **50** and Killeen Church **38**. There is a loud speaker outside the front door of Killeen and Tynagh Church.

**Social Distancing:** is still two meters. Observe it inside, outside, entering the church, in your seat, going to Holy Communion and leaving the church.

**Hand Hygiene:** Sanitiser provided at entrance and exit of our churches.  
**Our two Church are Sanitised:** After each ceremony, by our Volunteers.

**Wearing of Face coverings:** We encourage those attending church services to wear face covering. Wearing of face covering is essential, when staying two metres apart from people is difficult - in shops, shopping centres and on public transport, by people visiting the homes of those who are cocooning, by people who are being visited in their homes by those who are cocooning.
