Sanitiser: The Sanitiser in both our churches is operated by foot pedal. Put your hands under the nozzle and press your foot GENTLY on the foot pedal.

Welcome back to Mass from Monday 29th June 2020.

Familiarise yourself with the new church arrangements in Tynagh Church and Killeen Church adhering to Two Meters Social distancing. **Remember -**

- (1) Social Distancing is currently two meters.
 - Numbers in Church will be greatly reduced. Tynagh 50. Killeen 40.
 - Follow entrance and exit instructions.
 - Take the seat allotted (households may sit together).
 - Always keep two metres apart, entering church, in your seat, going to communion and leaving church (signage and stewards may be of assistance).
- (2) Hand Hygiene
 - Use sanitizer as provided at entrance and exits.
- (3) Respiratory Etiquette
 - Cough or sneeze appropriately.
- (4) During the Ceremony
 - There will be no handshake during the sign of peace and no hand shake even if you haven't seen someone for four months.
 - For the reception of Holy Communion follow the signs and the guidance given respecting social distance. The Act of Spiritual Communion will be prayer for the live broadcast and for anyone who may wish not to come to the altar for communion presently.
 - Please receive Holy Communion in the hand.
 - Take the newsletter home with you.
 - If you are a Reader / Eucharistic Minister / Member of the Choir / Teller / Adult Supervisor etc – what you were used to doing may now be different. Check beforehand with me. A back to work application form will need to be completed and signed before resuming ministry.
 - Boxes will be provided for your collection envelope / donations at the entrance on Sundays. No baskets will be passing through the seats.

Monday 29th June be seated in Tynagh at 9.20am for 9.30am Mass. Same in Killeen Tuesday, seated at 9.20am for 9.30am Mass. Saturday 4th July be seated in Killeen at 7.50pm. Tynagh Sunday 5th be seated in Tynagh at 10.50.

Our Masses will be live broadcasts on Facebook Live for the next few weeks.

After each ceremony, the church will be Sanitised.

If you are vulnerable or have flu symptoms, please join us from home.

Thank you for your understanding, co-operation and patience and please be respectful of each person as we adhere to the Government, HSE and Diocesan Guidelines to facilitate the return of congregations to Church Ceremonies.
