Level 5 Covid-19: Guidance for Parishes until further notice.

- (1) Our Two Churches are open for private prayer and lighting your candles.
- (2) There is no public Celebration of Mass or other Religious Services.
- (3) The Sacrament of Reconciliation, Sacrament of the Sick and the Sacrament of Baptism to be celebrated only in cases of grave necessity.
- (4) Funeral Mass with a maximum of 25 mourners present.
- (5) The Sacrament of Marriage with a maximum of 25 guests present.
- (6) All gatherings for parish related activities are to be moved on-line.
- (7) Our Parish Newsletter continues weekly and is available in both churches, on our Facebook Page and on our Parish website and in Harneys.
- (9) Collection envelopes can be dropped at any time in through the letter box of the inside door of my house.
