New Arrangements for Parish of Duniry and Abbey: We thank Fr Kieran
Danfulani for his ministry in the Parish of Duniry and Abbey. We wish him
well as he begins a new stage in his ministry. As you will be aware church
communities throughout the country are facing great challenges at present.
The numbers attending church have decreased. We have a decreasing and
ageing number of priests available to serve our parishes. I pray that in and
throughout it all the Holy Spirit is leading us to new and exciting ways of
living our faith. As a Diocese we have been working on how we might manage
such circumstances. These plans involve the closer working of parishes and
groups of parishes together. In line with this, I have appointed Father Seamus
Bohan PP, while continuing as PP of Tynagh and Killeen, to act as Moderator
(Parish Priest) of the Parish of Duniry and Abbey. I thank Father Bohan for
his generosity in taking on these additional responsibilities. In due course, I
hope to appoint a priest to live in the parish of Duniry and Abbey who along
with Fr Bohan will serve Abbey, Duniry, Tynagh and Killeen and possibly
some other neighbouring areas. While we await such an appointment we
have put in place the following arrangements for the Parish of Duniry and
Abbey. Saturday/Sunday Masses will take place as normal. Saturday 8pm in
Duniry, Sunday 10am in Abbey. Intentions for these Masses may be booked
for Abbey from Mrs Frances Holahan. For Duniry from Fr Bohan. Weekday
Masses are available in local parishes. For emergencies and funerals contact
Fr Bohan on 087 2304493. First Friday / Sick Calls – these will be scheduled
in due course. In such circumstances, the faith community of Duniry & Abbey
will need to find new ways to assist and support Fr Bohan in his ministry and
find new ways to sustain the involvement and participation of people in the
