Please read carefully and fully the following Guidelines.

Important Information for Our Masses from Monday 29th June.

Familiarise yourself with the new arrangements in Tynagh Church and Killeen Church which adheres to Two Meters Social distancing. **Remember -**

- (1) Social Distancing is currently two meters. Observe inside and outside.
 - Numbers in our Churches are greatly reduced. Tynagh 50. Killeen 38.
 - Follow the entrance and exit instructions from our Stewards.
 - Take the seat allotted to you. (Households may sit together).
 - Keep two metres apart, entering church, in your seat, going to and from communion and leaving church (signage and stewards to guide you).
- (2) Hand Hygiene – Wash your hands before you leave home.
 - Use sanitiser provided at entrance and exit of our churches.
- (3) Respiratory Etiquette
 - Cough or sneeze appropriately. Please use your sleeve or a tissue.
- (4) During the Ceremony
 - There will be no handshake at the sign of peace and no handshaking even if you have not seen someone for a long time.
 - For the reception of Holy Communion follow the signs and the guidance given respecting social distance. The Act of Spiritual Communion will be prayed for the live broadcast and by anyone who may wish not to come to the altar for Holy Communion presently.
 - Receive Holy Communion in the hand. Distributed only at the Altar.
 - Take the Parish Newsletter home with you. Don't leave it on the seat.
 - Readers / Eucharistic Ministers / Choirs / Tellers / Adult Supervisors / Volunteers etc – have to complete and sign a back to work application form before resuming ministry. You will be given this document to complete.
 - Boxes will be provided for your collection envelope / donations at the entrance on Sundays. No baskets will be passing through the seats.

This Monday 29th June be seated in Tynagh at 9.20am for 9.30am Mass. Same in Killeen on Tuesday, be seated at 9.20am for 9.30am Mass. Saturday 4th July be seated in Killeen at 7.50pm. Sunday 5th be seated in Tynagh at 10.50am.

Our Masses continue to be live broadcasts on our Parish Facebook Page. After each ceremony, the church will be Sanitised by our Volunteers.

Please feel free to wear a face mask. There will be no Holy Water in the Fonts. If you are vulnerable or have flu symptoms, please join us from your home.

Thank you for your understanding, co-operation and patience and please be respectful of each person as we adhere to the Government, HSE and Diocesan Guidelines facilitating the return of our congregations to Church Ceremonies.
