Community Alert: A new befriending service for older people has been launched by Michael Ring TD. If you have a personal alarm, supplied through Community Alert, and would like to avail of this befriending service you should test your alarm. The monitoring company will then ring you, and you can confirm you would like to avail of the service if you so wish. They will take the necessary details - your name, phone number, and your permission to pass your phone number on to the organisation 'Alone'. 'Alone' will then make contact with you. This is an extra service for older people who have any concerns relating to Covid-19. Your arrangement with your 3 contacts in the event of an emergency still exists and is separate from the above.
