The New Arrangements in Tynagh Church and Killeen Church.

Church Capacity: Tynagh Church FIFTY and Killeen Church THIRTY EIGHT. Follow the instructions of our Volunteer Stewards. Take the seat allotted to you. Households sit together. Speaker outside Killeen and Tynagh Church.

Social Distancing: is two meters. Observe it inside and outside each church, entering the church, in your seat, going to and from Holy Communion and leaving the church after Mass. The signage and stewards will guide you.

Hand Hygiene: Wash your hands before you leave home. Use the sanitiser provided at entrance and exit of our churches.

Respiratory Etiquette: Cough or sneeze appropriately. Please use your sleeve or a tissue.

Sign of Peace: No handshake at the sign of peace. Silent prayer for peace.

At Holy Communion: follow the signs and the guidance given respecting social distance. Receive Holy Communion on your hand only. Holy Communion will be distributed only at the Altar.

The Act of Spiritual Communion: will be prayed at each Mass for all who are following the live broadcast of Mass.

Newsletter: Take the Newsletter home with you. Do not leave it on the seat.

Return to Work Forms: Readers, Eucharistic Ministers, Tellers, Volunteers – must sign a back to work application form before resuming ministry.

Collection Boxes: Boxes will be placed inside the church entrance for your collection envelope, contribution on Sundays. No baskets passed around.

For Church Rubrics during Mass: This Saturday 4th July be seated in Killeen at 7.50pm for 8pm Mass. This Sunday 5th be seated in Tynagh at 10.50am.

Church Sanitised: After each ceremony, the church will be Sanitised by our Volunteers. Extra volunteers always welcome. Just let me know 087 2304493

Holy Water: There will be no Holy Water in the Church Fonts.
