Chrism Mass 2020: Normally, each year during Holy week, the priests and people of Clonfert Diocese gather to bless the oils used in the celebration of the sacraments during that year. At that Mass the Priests also renew their priestly vows. Covid-19 restrictions meant that this could not happen this year. However, the Chrism Mass will be celebrated this Tuesday 8th September, the Feast of Our Lady's Birthday at the Cathedral of St. Brendan, Loughrea. During the Mass Bishop Duignan will bless the new Oil of Chrism for use at Baptism and Confirmation, also the Oil of Catechumens used at Baptism and the Oil of The Sick used in the celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick.
