Congregation at Masses: The Taoiseach has confirmed that the public celebration of Mass can resume on Monday 29th June, with congregation present. Further guidelines will be issued by our Bishop during the week.

Church Preparation for Public Present at Mass: For three months I have celebrated Mass without a congregation present following the government and HSE guidelines. Like everyone else we are now planning to have the public back in our churches for the celebration of Mass. We will need help to do so, especially from people who might have experience in the areas of stewarding, sanitising, cleaning, or signage, etc. We cannot yet have a Parish Pastoral Council meeting, so please if you can help, make contact with me, Fr Séamus on 087 2304493 so I can begin putting working groups together.

3. With 2 metre distancing what is the capacity of each Sacristy?
4. How will people enter maintaining 2 metres distance?
5. How will people exit maintaining 2 metres distance?
6. How might communion be arranged maintaining 2 metres distance?
