**First Holy Communion 2020:** for Tynagh School and Killeen School will take place in Tynagh Church on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> June at 12 Noon.

**First Holy Communion 2021:** will take place in the Autumn in accordance with the government request. A date will be scheduled at a later date.

**Confirmation 2021:** will be in the Autumn, also in accordance with the government request. Bishop Duignan is issuing Confirmation dates in July.

**Tynagh and Kilcorban Cemetery Masses:** will not be in June. I will schedule dates for them as soon as the government allows us to have large gathering at outdoor ceremonies, which hopefully will be in the Autumn. For the moment, outdoor gatherings for worship are not permitted.

**Congregations at Mass:** The public celebration of all Sunday Masses and Weekday Masses resumes this Monday 10<sup>th</sup> May in the Parish of Tynagh and Killeen. Fifty people is the number we are permitted to have in attendance at the celebration of each Eucharist. See you on Monday morning at 9.30am.
